

Points scale for the individual ranking

Riders belonging to a UCI ProTeam score points in UCI ProTour races based on the scale featured below. Riders who are part of a UCI Professional Continental Team do not score any points. The points corresponding to the place obtained are not awarded.

Points awarded for stages are calculated on the last day of the race.

The team time-trial award points to riders from the 10 best teams.

Points scale for the team ranking

At the end of one-day races, points are awarded to the first 3 riders from each team. These points determine the team's ranking in the race, which consequently determines the final number of points obtained by the team (see scale below).

Teams may also earn points according to their position in the final classification of stage races.

The UCI ProTour team ranking is calculated based on the scale below.

Points scale for the country ranking

The country ranking is worked out on the basis of points obtained by the 5 first riders of each nationality in the individual ranking (art. 2.10.008 of the UCI Rules).
